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Objectives

- Feasible and low-threshold, and low-cost facilitation concepts for **secondary school teachers** and learning modules for secondary school **students** on Augmented and Immersive Reality (A&IR) learning technologies
- School teachers and students will be equipped with the necessary skills and competences to facilitate and **apply innovative learning approaches and open-source A&IR** learning technology solutions in existing courses, curricula and study projects.



Activities

- **Stocktaking** of A&IR learning experiences in secondary schools contexts across Europe
- Develop **competence frameworks** on A&IR
- **CPD** for teachers
- Transferable **certified courses for students and teachers** on A&IR;
- An **open learning hub** providing accessible offers for learning and facilitation of A&IR and a simple and affordable A&IR educational content development and fruition tool that can be used on mobile devices.



Results

- **Certified courses** and transferable learning units on A&IR that will be made available on an open learning hub.
- These products will be **piloted with secondary school students** in innovative design based collaborative learning and research formats.
- 30 students will take part in a didactic treasure hunt designed by the students themselves in cooperation with the teachers.
- 18 secondary school **teachers will be trained as facilitators**.
- A **large-scale conference**.




Monitoring Quality & Quantity

- Continuous indicator-based monitoring
- For each WP, a set of **Indicators**, **qualitative** and **quantitative**, with a base value and a target have been defined.
- Pay close attention to these indicators to assess the quality of the project.
- A **self-evaluation** will be required at the end of the project based on these indicators
- As suggested by our National Agency we are considering possible **external monitoring** for a higher level of quality.

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
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WP2 - Stocktaking on Innovative learning formats and Competence framework - Leader: EPAL

A. Collection of Innovative learning formats

- Building research framework and methodology – Lead: EPAL, support CNR
- Developing research instruments - all partners
- Quantitative research (datapool, marketing, distributing, data collection) all partners
- Qualitative research (Design leading questions) - all partners
- Data representation, Interpretation, Evaluation - all partners
- Inserting data pool and inventory of good practice on the platform - all partners
- Monitoring, quality control, reporting - EPAL

B. Competence Framework for A&IR implementation and facilitation

- Creating a competence inventory of A&IR learning and facilitation competences - CNR, 2Epal
- Describing competences along EQF (qualification) and LEVEL5 (learning) taxonomies - all partners

- Section 1 - Learning suite
 - Blinc, supported by CNR will develop and adapt the platform technology.
 - All partners will adapt and upload material
- Section 2 - Virtual exhibition space
 - Each partner will coordinate the establishment of the content offers. Offline descriptive patterns will be developed and distributed by the partners to a fixed number of potential SCHOOL professionals, institutions and also local ARIES projects.
 - Each partner should collect information (texts and multimedia materials) of at least 15 stakeholders and publish them in the virtual exhibition space.
- Section 3 - KA1 Platform
 - Each partner will coordinate with potential KA1 CPD providers (courses, job shadowing, conferences) and teachers and educational professionals and support them with providing their offers on the platform.
- Section 4 - ARLectio platform:
 - CNR will adapt it to ARIES and the secondary school sector.



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WP5 - Valorisation: European School Network - Leader: DIDZDVARIS

A. Valorisation Strategy and Instruments:

- ARIES valorisation concept as planning outline for mainstreaming the project approach, methodology and instruments: Developed by Didzdvaris as the basis for its monitoring activities in WP5.

B. Repository of Certified courses and materials in secondary school education

- An overarching manual and toolbox for the facilitation concept for both the validation and the competence oriented learning approach - All partners
- A labelling system to recognise and valorise the measures for standardisation, comparability and transparency for the qualification of school professionals on the introduction of A&IR learning technologies. The European label will be a tangible and easily identifiable sign with a strong connection with the community's values and principles - All partners
- A toolkit/compendium which contains all relevant materials from the stocktaking reports, training and learning materials - All partners
